## JUDGES' LIST CRITERIA AND APPLICATION FORM 2016/2017

### A1 List

**Criteria:** persons having been approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in Irish Terriers, completed their first appointment and have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club :-

### A3 List

Judges who will be supported by this Club if proposed to award Challenge Certificates in Irish Terriers.

### Breed specialist judges

**Criteria:** Have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club;  
To have at least seven years experience in judging Irish Terriers and have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club;

To have judged a minimum of 30 Irish Terriers and including an Irish Terrier Breed Open Show or a Championship Show without CC's;

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures;

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement;

To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable;

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances);

To have stewarded for at least 3 years and at 12 shows (any breed); and

To have attended during the last three years at least nine from Club Shows (any level) or Championship Shows with IT CCs.

### **All-round judges**

**Criteria:** Have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club;

To have at least seven years' judging experience (any breed) and five years judging experience of ITs;

To have stewarded for at least 3 years and at 12 shows (any breed);

To have attended during the last three years at least nine from Club Shows (any level); and/or Championship Show judging with CCs for ITs on offer; and/or Breed Seminars;

To have judged at least 30 ITs preferably including a breed club open show;

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures;

To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement and passed the assessment; attend and pass the Points of a Dog assessment.

To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable;

To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed;

To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).

### **B List**

Judges who will be supported by this Club to judge Irish Terriers at shows where Challenge Certificates are not on offer.

### **Breed specialist judges**

**Criteria:** Have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club;

To have owned or exhibited ITs for at least three years;

To have attended during the last three years at least six from Club Shows (any level), and/or Championship Show judging with CCs on offer for ITs, and/or Breed seminars;

Stewarded at least three shows (any breed);

Have demonstrated extensive showing experience; judging experience including judging 10 dogs which may include no more than 5 dogs from seminars.

### **All-round judges**

**Criteria:** Have the support of the North of England Irish Terrier Club;

To have attended during the last three years at least nine from Club Shows (any level), and/or Championship Show judging with CCs on offer for ITs, and/or Breed seminars;

To have during the last three years stewarded at least three shows (any breed);

To have demonstrated extensive showing and/or judging experience including judging at least 10 dogs of IT which may include no more than 5 dogs from seminars.

Be on at least a B list for another breed.

**C List**

Judges who will be supported by this Club to judge at Limited Shows and at Open Shows (up to three classes).

**Criteria:** Have the support of The North of England Irish Terrier Club; have demonstrated a current, active interest in Irish Terriers, e.g. have attended at least three Club Shows within the past five years; Have a basic understanding of judging through exhibiting, handling, stewarding or involvement with show organisation
